## Course Overview:

The purpose of this course is to train and educate the general diving public in entry-level techniques of first aid management of suspected dive accidents, through the use of oxygen. In addition, the course will introduce divers to the fundamentals of dive accident, recognition, response, and management, and will provide experienced divers and instructors with an excellent opportunity to continue their education. The goals of this course are to:

Recognise the signs and symptoms of near-drowning, arterial gas embolism and decompression sickness.

Develop the skill and confidence during the proper assembly, deployment, use and disassembly of all component parts of the oxygen unit. This includes the demand inhalator valve and mask, constant flow non-rebreather mask and pocket mask with supplementary oxygen inlet.

Be able to provide emergency oxygen to a simulated injured diver.

Be able to identify the main components of the oxygen unit.

## Course Prerequisites:

1. PADI Open Water Diver or an equivalent rating. Equivalency is defined as proof of entry level certification with a minimum of four scuba training dives.

Recommended

2. PADI Rescue Diver

3. Current First Aid/CPR qualification from a nationally recognised organisation. PADI Medic First Aid certification is strongly recommended.
